1. Say whether these sentences are true or false according to the text and copy the evidence from the text that justifies your answer: (3x0.5=1.5 points)

Both the T/F choice and the justification must be correct.

- **a.** FALSE. "He applied this kind of creative sculpting to music as well as to all aspects of his life".
- **b.** TRUE. "As a live entertainer Freddy Mercury was magnificent". From "He would feed off ..." to "... stage talent" may also be considered part of the answer.
- **c.** TRUE. "Reputed to have led a flamboyant and hedonistic lifestyle, he was also known to be generous and kind to the same extreme".

2. Answer the following questions about the text. Use complete sentences. (3x1=3 points)

For each answer: 0,5 points if the information is correct and 0,5 more if it is correctly expressed.

- A. Answer must contain at least: "He was the lead singer". It may contain more detailed information, such as "and composed many of the band's best songs".
- **B.** Because (for its creation) he used the Zodiac signs of the four members of the band.
- C. Because during the concert the audience was constantly thrilled by the band. (More literal answers extracted from the text may also be considered, providing they are adapted to reply to the question given, namely, "Why?-Because").
